



## Board Meeting Highlights

### **Ride of the Mustang – riding for a cause**

- In support of a fellow peer diagnosed with cancer, in 2011 students from George McDougall High School started Ride of the Mustang to raise funds for Kids Helping Kids through the Alberta Children's Hospital.
- In its inaugural year, 42 teams comprised of 400 staff and students, sweated it out on stationary bikes for 48 consecutive hours, raising \$51,000 for the hospital foundation to put towards life-saving equipment, programs and family-centred care in support of sick or injured kids.
- Today, Ride of the Mustang has expanded to 65 teams, representing over 700 participants, and has raised more than \$940,000 – inching closer towards the \$1 million goal.

### **Trustees affirm Board Policy 26 and approve Schedule of School Fees**

- In accordance with government regulations, Trustees approved the *2019/20 Schedule of School Fees* for approval by the Minister of Education.
- School administrators worked closely with their staff, students and parent councils to determine programming, field trips and budgets/fundraising prior to submitting the proposed fees for the 2019/20 school year.
- Once the list is approved by the Minister, the *Schedule of School Fees* will be posted on individual school websites.

### **Trustees approve Site Plan for Horse Creek Development in Cochrane**

- The Board approved the Horse Creek Sports Park Masterplan just off the northwest corner of the Town of Cochrane.
- Once all parties have approved the plan, further details will be released.

### **Trustees approve a home for The Farm**

- With the entire curriculum delivered through the lens of agriculture, The Farm is a program of choice that will offer students an engaging, alternative learning experience.
- The program will be anchored by relationships with our community and partners.
- The Board is pleased to reach an agreement with landowner Mr. Wayne Hanson, allowing the program to operate on the northwest edge of Airdrie.

### **Trustees approve Airdrie Reserves Land Agreement**

- The Board accepts the Airdrie Reserve Land Agreement, as presented at the May 21, 2019, meeting with the City of Airdrie, The Calgary Catholic Separate School District No.1 and Le Conseil scolaire FrancoSud.
- Once all parties have approved the agreement, further details will be released.
